Some of the topics you will find in our lessons:

- Creating enjoyable tummy time
- Relief of colic symptoms and gas pains
- Developing free movement in joints
- Using a baby carrier
- Developing the ability to lie comfortably on both sides
- Midline awareness and crossing midline
- Exposure to different textures
- Developing and improving balance abilities and all developmental milestones

What will I get from the program?

- You will learn 30 essential group lessons that every parent should be taught for his baby's first year.
- You will improve your group teaching skills and gain confidence for starting your own groups.
- You will learn from live demos and films of classes.
- You will enrich your knowledge about stage appropriate sensorimotor activities and play.

All lessons will include: group dynamics, developing parents' awareness of their bodies and movement, circle dancing & different holding positions, face-to-face rhymes and songs.

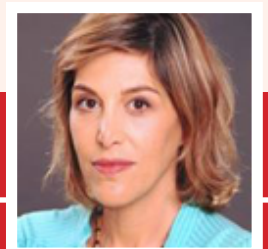
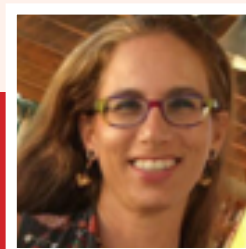
Why Child'Space groups?
